

### Maria Guinand

Maria Guinand, choral/orchestral conductor of international performance and recording acclaim, university professor, El Sistema advocate.

Venezuelan Maria Guinand founded the choirs *Cantori Alberto Grau* and *Orfeon Univeritario Simon Bolivar* and currently conducts the *Schola Cantorum de Venezuela*. This choir has premiered 45 recent works and is the chorus for the premiere recordings of Osvaldo Golijov's *St Mark Passion* and John Adams' opera *The Flowering Tree*; and with the Grechinger Cantori of Germany, premiere of Alberto Grau's *Aqua*. She has been presented with three international culture awards; and her choirs have won competitions in Switzerland, Italy and Austria.

A graduate of Bristol University, England, Maria also studied choral conducting with Alberto Grau, Helmut Rilling, Luigi Astoni and Johannes Guesch. She teaches in the Masters Degree for Choral Conducting at the Venezuela Simon Bolivar University, and has been, for more than 30 years, Associate Conductor and Advisor of Choral Symphonic Performances and Activities of *El Sistema*, co-ordinating choral centres for children and youth of low economic resources in Venezuela, other Latin-American countries and in Barcelona, Spain.

She has conducted in Amsterdam, Buenos Aires, London, Los Angeles, New York, Oregon State, Porto, Sydney and Stuttgart and her repertoire includes Bach: Mass in B Minor/St John Passion/various cantatas; Mozart: Mass in C Minor/Coronation Mass/Requiem; Mendelssohn: Elijah; Brahms: German Requiem; Bernstein: Chichester Psalms; Stravinsky: Symphony of Psalms; Grau: La Doncella.

Her *Sing for Life* selections will include Victoria, Bach, Durufle and music of Latin and South America.
